ANDERSON WORKS TO BRING JOBS TO MICHIGAN



Senator Anderson supports incentives to create jobs in Michigan.

Senator Anderson supported passage of the \$335 million Michigan Advanced Battery Credits initiative, the first of its kind in the United States, which will create automotive jobs by spurring production of advanced batteries for electric and hybrid vehicles. These incentives already helped encourage a Massachusetts-based company to invest over \$600 million which is expected to create over 5,000 jobs in our area.

He backed film credit legislation that has already generated over \$100 million in job creating expenditures by the film industry, including over \$9.3 million spent in our community, creating at least 200 jobs. These new industry jobs also generate economic activity for other local businesses in our community.

ANDERSON FIGHTS TO PROTECT CONSUMERS

As Michigan's economic struggles have hit families hard, State Senator Glenn Anderson has focused on helping residents protect their pocketbooks.

- He voted for a plan that will invest \$17.8 million to create jobs and help Wayne County residents save on their energy costs.
- As Michigan's housing market continues to struggle and home values have declined, **he voted to stop property taxes from rising when home values go down.**
- Senator Anderson supported legislation that protects homeowners from foreclosure and provides an additional 90 days to negotiate with lenders for reasonable payments.



HIGH PRIORITY ON JOB TRAINING



Senator Anderson continues to push for critical job training for displaced Michigan workers and incentives to hire our residents first.

Anderson fought for funding for the Michigan Nursing Corps, providing a new classroom and clinical facility to train Registered Nurses, one of Michigan's growing job sectors.

He helped secure a \$335,274 job training grant for Schoolcraft College to help retrain local manufacturing employees.

Senator Anderson continues to support programs such as Hire Michigan First and No Worker Left Behind, which will reduce the number of people on assistance by putting people back to work.
