LANSING-State Senator Mark Schauer (D-Battle Creek) is hosting his sixth annual National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) Legislative Day today at the State Capitol. NAACP executive committee members from the Albion, Battle Creek and Jackson branches are visiting Lansing to discuss pressing issues such as the state budget process, economic growth initiatives, and tax assistance for struggling workers.
